The Past and the Future of St. Elizabeth

Introductions were made by Bob Wineland who grew up very near St. E's. The Presentation was done by Carter Wormeley from the GSA and Chris Mills from the Dept. of Homeland Security (DHS). Carter set the stage with a few slides about the history of St. E's, its buildings, and some of its more famous residents. Chris then used the slides to show us the DHS plans to consolidate activities and elements from over 50 agencies and locations throughout the DC area into a unified DHS campus. The DHS Stage 1 (of 3) effort has started with construction on the West Campus of St. E's. (west of MLK, Jr Ave) which will be located on the East Campus along with the working hospital run by the DC government. Another major element of DHS's Phase I is the building of a new Coast Guard HQs along I 295 across from Bolling AFB. As they proceed with completion of these plans they are also starting to look at the future for additional efforts to enhance DHS effectiveness. In a few years we may want to have Carter and Chris back to catch up with ongoing DHS consolidation efforts.
